

Appointed by Governor Jim Pillen, Jewel Rodgers is the 2025–2029 Nebraska State Poet, an interdisciplinary poet, performer, and visual artist whose work centers on creativity, community, and connection. A three-time OEAA nominee for Best Performance Poet, a 2022 Union for Contemporary Art Fellow, and a 2023 Andy Warhol Populus Fund Grantee, Jewel has earned recognition for her ability to use poetry as a transformative tool for education and empowerment.

As a Buffett Scholar, she earned her Bachelor's degree in Business Administration from the University of Nebraska-Lincoln. During her time there, she competed on the UNL slam poetry team, contributed to the Husker Dialogues Diversity Training program, and served as a teaching artist for All Writes Reserved (previously known as Louder Than A Bomb). She also lent her words to numerous social engagements, including the 2018 Women's March in Lincoln, NE, the 2017 Charlottesville Vigil, and a variety of other social and institutional interventions. These included THINK., a traveling conversation series. well community as performances at festivals, conferences, and showcases.

Jewel further advanced her expertise, earning a Master's in Real Estate Development from New York University while serving as Slam Poetry President of NYU, bridging her passion for creative expression with reshaping the built environment through PlaceMade, a neighborhood group creating community amenities as an interim solution to blight.

Need:

Nebraska faces a critical challenge in literacy proficiency, with only 59% of students (grades 3-8) and 45% of high schoolers meeting English Language Arts (ELA) standards. With a state goal of 75% proficiency by 2030, innovative and engaging literacy interventions are essential to improving student outcomes.

Spoken word poetry has been proven to enhance literacy, reading comprehension, critical thinking, and public speaking—bringing language to life in ways that traditional methods often fail to do. When strategically positioned, a State Poet can serve as a catalyst for measurable improvements in literacy engagement across rural and urban communities.

Beyond education, the arts foster civic engagement and economic growth. In Nebraska, 73% of residents believe the arts help them better understand other cultures, and the sector contributes \$2.9 billion to the state's economy, yielding a nearly 50x return on investment from public and private philanthropy.

For the past eight years, my work in spoken word and community development has reached over 5,000 midwesterners, leading to transformative moments—like a student at Omaha South High School suddenly understanding consent through poetry or an audience member discovering a newfound appreciation for literature. My grassroots initiatives, including the largest poetry showcase in Omaha's recent history, the development of

two community parks and numerous urban impact projects demonstrate the power of the arts to create lasting change.

The mission of the Nebraska State Poet is to advocate for poetry, literature, and literacy across the state. Spoken word plays a vital role in this mission by bridging the arts with real-world skills, demonstrating its tangible impact beyond creative expression. It is uniquely suited to develop the 'Three C's'—Critical Thinking, Communication, and Creativity—by engaging students and lifelong learners in essential, transferable skills that today's employers value.

With your support, I will travel the state sharing poetry, while building the capacity of young people and all people to be better communicators, think more critically, and express themselves clearly and creatively while making a tangible impact on Nebraska literacy goals and our community's access to the arts.

To fully realize this potential, I need the opportunity to dedicate 100% of my time and energy to expanding this impact across the state. Your investment will allow me to bring literacy engagement, civic awareness, and artistic expression to new communities, reaching Nebraskans who have yet to experience the transformative power of the spoken word.

With Nebraska facing critical challenges in literacy and arts accessibility, the role of the Nebraska State Poet has never been more essential.

Spoken word is uniquely suited to bridging the gap between creative expression and real-world skills, fostering critical thinking, communication, and creativity—all essential for literacy proficiency and workforce development. During my tenure as State Poet, I will travel across Nebraska, reaching hundreds of sites, including schools, libraries, and festivals, to ensure that poetry is not just heard but experienced.

In addition to these statewide visits, I will lead a coordinated initiative to expand poetry's reach, nurture emerging writers, and create meaningful connections between Nebraska and the broader literary world. With the right support, this vision is both ambitious and achievable.

This funding provides the foundation needed to expand programming, enhance accessibility, and build a lasting infrastructure for Nebraska's literary community.

Your investment will be allocated as follows:

• 60% - Foundational Support

- Covers essential living, travel, and event-organizing expenses
- Enables me to lead workshops, curate events, and purchase equipment that expands my digital reach, in addition to my physical presence

- Supports the development of two poetry workshops or discussions.
- Helps print outreach materials and educational resources to increase accessibility.
